Mohamed Shahin of Cairo, Egypt is a world-renowned dancer, instructor & choreographer of Egyptian Folk & Oriental dances. His expertise includes all styles of Egyptian dance, including Oriental (Raqs Sharqi), Saidi, Shaabi, Tannoura (Whirling Dervish) & a lot more. As an innovative choreographer, Mohamed's magnetic personality has made him a highly sought-after dance mentor throughout the world. He has taught dance workshops & performed in 5 continents.

A trained mechanical engineer, Mohamed discovered his passion for Egyptian dance at the age of fourteen. His training began with the famous "Kawmia Troupe" where he earned his degree in Egyptian Folklore. Mohamed has been dancing with the most renowned Egyptian folkloric teachers such as Mahmoud Reda, Hassan Afifi, Kamal Naim, Hamada Hossam & many others. Mohamed has also appeared on many Egyptian TV shows, theaters, 5-star hotels, music videos & films as a dancer & choreographer. He trains his own folklore dance troupe & served as artistic director for Egyptian singer Samir Sabry's dance troupe.

Mohamed teaches regularly at the international Dance Festival "Ahlan wa Sahlan" in Cairo, Egypt, and is one of the founders of "Sharqiyat, the first Middle Eastern Dance Festival in Puerto Rico. He has taught dance workshops and performed in Brazil, South Korea, Malaysia, Greece, Turkey, South Africa, Lebanon, Russia, Colombia, Cyprus and most of the year he teaches in the USA.

In recent years, Mohamed's prolific contributions to Egyptian dance, in the form of teaching tours, instructional DVDs, spectacular performances (many of which may be seen on YouTube.com), organizing events and more, have gained him a vast amount of popularity and name recognition.
